The Cuyahoga County Solar Co-op, offered in partnership with Solar United Neighbors, enables its members to save money by negotiating below market group rate pricing.

Members learn about all aspects of rooftop solar and vendor-neutral support throughout the entire process. Over 100 solar installations were completed through Cuyahoga County's 2022 Co-op. Each of these households is predicted to save an estimated \$10,000 - \$25,000 over 25 years.
